How to certify your signature at the notary? Statement – qualified certificate for electronic signature

Instructions Notarial Certification of Signature

1. The Notarial Certification of Signature should contain:

- 1. **the Subscriber's identifier** which will be included in the data for the certificate (e.g. **personal number**, **series and number of passport** or **ID card**),
- 2. **the date of expiry of the identity document** on the basis of which the identity was confirmed,
- 3. the details of the document on the basis of which the identity was confirmed (series and number, issuing body),
- 4. the type of the identity document (passport or ID card).
- **1.1.** The Notary prepares a notarial certificate of signature under the "*Statement qualified certificate for electronic signature*".
- **1.2.** The notarial certificate must be an integral part of the signed document , that is the *"Statement – qualified certificate for electronic signature"*, i.e. it can be provided:
 - on the "Statement qualified certificate for electronic signature",
 - in the form of a separate document **permanently attached** to the "*Statement qualified certificate for electronic signature*",
 - in the form of a notarial deed unambiguously indicating the signing of the *"Statement qualified certificate for electronic signature"* by the client.
- **1.3.** If the notarial certification is **in a language other than Polish and English** it must be translated by a sworn translator into Polish or English **before delivering it to the Certum headquarters**.
- **1.4.** In the case of notarial certification of signature, it is necessary to be able to check whether the person who certified the signature provided is a notary in the official register in the given country.
- **1.5.** We do not accept notarially certified identity documents and notarial certifications of signature which contain a permanently attached copy of the identity document.
- **1.6.** A certificate of signature may also be issued at a **Polish consulate**. The certification is performed by a consul. In this case, we proceed in the same way as in the notary's case.
